## **FIRE SAFETY**

For your safety and the safety of your fellow residents the fire department has drawn up rules and regulations for residential complexes. These rules and regulations are part of the rental agreement.

### **FIRE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOU**

You will ensure that escape routes and common areas, such as stairways, halls, galleries, entrances and – in residential groups – corridors and stairs behind the group's front door and in front of the room-doors (traffic areas) are free of obstacles and remain easy to reach. Therefore, it is not allowed to place crates, laundry, bikes, electrical appliances or other goods in the escape routes or in areas with a traffic destination. Escape routes and traffic areas, inside and outside the residential complex, must always be a safe environment for everyone (tenants, passers-by and animals).

Causing a fire hazardous situation (the risk of a fire breaking out or extending) is not allowed. If such a situation occurs, it is not allowed to prevent or obstruct alarming, controlling or fleeing away from it.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM US**

You will receive written instructions on how to keep your residential complex fire safe. In addition, during their visits our district consultants will pay attention to the use of areas and the placing of goods in them. If they find a situation that does not comply with the fire regulations, they will draw your attention to it. We expect that you, as a tenant, will follow their directions.

If you don't, the goods will be removed by us after a written warning. Any additional expenses made by us will be charged to the owner/owners of the goods.
